**If your 7526 Terminal is experiencing erratic barcode reads, and you are using Ethernet....It could be too much traffic on you network is causing the processor to dedicate too much time looking for messages. One circumstance showed this during the recent virus attacks this year. There is available later Ethernet flash that will help to minimize this problem. It adds an Ethernet broadcast function onto the configuration menu, which allows you to select it to be on or off.**
